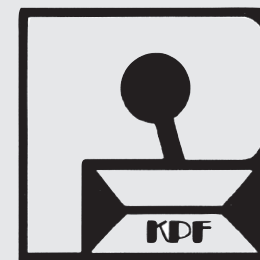

Amounts above assume \$500 Annual Premium on Standard Issue risks in each class. The \$500 premium is payable for 12 years until the policy is paid-up. Actual face amounts will be based on the underwriting of the insured life.

How It Works

The life insurance policies will be issued to the members of this group based upon what a premium of \$500 will purchase at their current age and health. These premiums will be payable over a 12 year period. After 12 years the policies will be paid-up, meaning no future premiums will be due, but the policies will continue until the insured's death. Upon the death of the member the Foundation will receive the proceeds to support the future of our organization.

Goals

1. Encourage and assist in the professional enrichment of pharmacists.
2. Encourage pharmacy public relations and consumer education.
3. Improve and expand the quality and scope of pharmaceutical services through innovation and improvement.
4. Cooperate and support the Kansas Pharmacists Association in areas of mutual interest.
5. Encourage programs that generate positive public attitude towards pharmacy and the positive self-esteem of pharmacists.
6. Encourage and promote pharmacy education.
7. Provide and maintain office facilities for the Kansas pharmacy organizations.

Activities & Projects

- ★ Provide educational training programs for pharmacists—e.g. enhance skills to meet the requirements of Medicare Part D Medication Therapy Management Services
- ★ Conduct public awareness programs for the public emphasizing the value and services of the pharmacist
- ★ Support projects of the Kansas Pharmacists Association
- ★ Provide educational training programs for the pharmacy technician community in Kansas
- ★ Provide public forums or workshops for the public community to enhance the safety and effectiveness of medication therapy
- ★ Provide research funds to the pharmacist community for studies for advanced pharmaceutical care services
- ★ Provide education opportunities for Kansas pharmacy students such as internships, residencies, or young pharmacists' programs
- ★ Encourage pharmacy student participation in pharmacy organizations through financial support for attendance at related meetings
- ★ Maintain and financially support an Executive Internship for a pharmacy student each summer to provide the intern with an orientation to the organizational functions, goals, and activities of the Foundation
- ★ Support student recruitment programs for pharmacy school
- ★ Provide a repository of public education materials and programs to support a Speaker's Bureau for practitioners
- ★ Provide recognition programs for pharmacists with innovative practices

LEG participants will be recognized on a plaque to be permanently displayed at the Kansas Pharmacy Center. All participants will receive a lapel pin to designate them as members of this exclusive group. Recognition will also be provided in the KPF publications and at the annual meeting of Kansas pharmacists.
